## **Wine & Food Paring**

Consider the weight of the food & wine. A full flavored dish goes well w a full bodied wine & vice versa. The following is only a guide & remember, you can never go wrong if you just choose a wine you enjoy drinking by itself.

### **Champagne & Sparkling Wines**

Ideal w salads, carpaccio, salty foods, shell fish served chilled especially oysters & caviar, seafood in light sauces, paté, fruit based desserts.

### **Full bodied White Wines**

Chardonnay, Semillon, Viognier, Albarino

Ideal w spicy Asian (Duck Leg, Indian Butter Chicken Curry), seafood pasta, risotto, all seafood & shell fish such as prawns & bugs, carpaccio, pork, paté & hard cheeses.

### **Medium Bodied White Wines**

Verdelho, Sauvignon Blanc Semillon (light to medium), Pinot Gris

Ideal w spicy Asian, pasta, risotto, all seafood, chicken & soft cheeses.

### **Light to Medium Bodied White Wines**

Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Grigio

Ideal w salads, spicy light Asian, garlic & oil pasta dishes, all seafood especially oysters, antipasto, pork, fetta, goats cheese & gruyere cheeses.

### **Full Bodied Red Wines**

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Merlot, Cabernet Shiraz, Shiraz

Ideal w beef, pork, veal, lamb, duck, meat pasta, red curry & hard cheeses.

### **Medium Bodied Red Wines**

Merlot, Merlot Cabernet

Ideal w beef, lamb, duck, meat pasta, curry & hard cheeses.

### **Light Bodied Red Wines**

Pinot Noir

Ideal w lamb, duck, veal, pork, meat pasta, vegetarian & soft cheeses.

### **Very Light Bodied Red Wines**

Rose

Ideal w shellfish, chicken, salads & soft cheeses.
